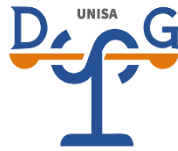

All applications should include a CV, the indication of whether you would be interested in publishing in an EJHL special issue related to the workshop, along with an abstract on your research topic.

Kindly consider the following requirements for the abstract:

1. All abstracts should be submitted in MS Office Word file of max 2 pages.
2. The text format: Times New Roman, font – 14, line spacing – 1,5. **Unformatted text will not be considered and will be returned to the sender.**
3. The abstracts will be assessed based on the following criteria:
 - It must cover your PhD/research topic.
 - Topic must reflect European health-law related issues. Applicants should consider that at least one session of the Workshop will be devoted to EU health law, hence we strongly invite proposals addressing key issues concerning the European Health Union, the EU Global Health Strategy, and One Health.
 - The language spelling should be British English.

Participation fee is € 50, which includes meals during the day and a social dinner.

We are also happy to announce that The European Association of Health Law is sponsoring travel and accommodation for up to 20 selected candidates whose costs are not covered by their home institutions. See the Document “CALL for application – Sponsorship for PhD Candidates”.
